**“Casey Powell Named to Starting Lineup
for 2009 NLL All-Star Game”**

New York – February 17, 2009 – The New York Titans today announced that Casey Powell has been voted onto the starting lineup of the Eastern Division team for the National Lacrosse League All-Star Game, which will be played at the Pepsi Center in Denver on Saturday, March 7th. Powell currently leads the National Lacrosse League in scoring with 26 goals and is second in assists with 26.

Casey’s 2009 season can best be described as one for the record books with six goals and four assists at the NLL’s inaugural Florida Lacrosse Cup against the Toronto Rock, back on January 3rd. In week two of the season, Casey had three goals and five assists in a win over the expansion Boston Blazers in the Titans home opener at the Prudential Center in Newark, NJ. Casey’s hot hand continued the following weekend in Boston with three goals and six assists to shut down the Blazers in their home opener at the TD Banknorth Garden. Next, it was off to Rochester where he ripped off four goals and two assists in the Titans victory over the Knighthawks and their fourth loss of the season. Casey was on a roll and could not be stopped. In Denver the following weekend, Powell added three goals and two assists, but, it was not enough to keep the Titans winning streak alive. The Titans returned to the East coast and Boston the following weekend looking to get back on the winning track. Consistent Casey scored two goals and added two assists to his tally for the year and if it were not for a goal by Boston rookie Kyle Ross with .5 seconds left on the clock, the Titans might have taken two

wins on the weekend. Twenty four hours later, the Titans were back at the Prudential Center in Newark, NJ and the Titans train got back on the winning track with three goals and three assists from Casey to take a much needed win over the Philadelphia Wings, 15-12. In week seven, the World's Most Famous Arena, Madison Square Garden, once again played host to the Titans for the first time in the '09 season. The Titans recorded their fourth win of the season with two goals and two assists from their captain to record a 15-9 win over the Rochester Knighthawks.

The Eastern and Western Division starting lineups were determined by the combined votes of the league's general managers, league media and fans. The reserves for the Eastern and Western teams will be announced later this week. The National Lacrosse League's All-Star weekend kicks off March 6 when Denver's Pepsi Center plays host to the NLL All-Star Skills Challenge. The West All-Stars will face off against the East All-Stars on March 7th at 7 p.m. MT. Live coverage of both the Skill Challenge and the East vs. West Game can be seen on the NLL Network at NLL.com.

The Titans will travel to the Blue Cross Arena in Rochester next Saturday, February 21st to play their third game of the regular season against the Knighthawks at 7:35 PM. The following Saturday, February 28th, they will return to the World's Most Famous Arena, Madison Square Garden, to go head-to-head with the Calgary Roughnecks at 7 PM.
